CrossLink acquires most of their medical materials by donation from local hospitals and individuals or at cost from pharmaceutical companies. Much of these supplies is excess and would otherwise be thrown out. CrossLink has developed highly effective delivery systems to ensure that remote hospitals and clinics receive their custom supply orders to treat thousands of sick and injured patients each year.

CrossLink uses donations of money to buy materials and cover the cost of shipping massive quantities of medicines, surgical supplies, diagnostic tools and other equipment to support free clinics, mission hospitals, and medical mission teams in the US and over 118 third world countries including; Honduras, Kenya and Romania. Since its incorporation as a 501 c 3 charity in 1996, CrossLink has distributed over \$26 million in supplies.
